

**Terms of Reference**

- 1) To advise on
  - (i) ways and means to rejuvenate the bamboo industry, both small enterprises and cottage industry, as well as the larger commercial units to enable a definite role in both domestic markets and for exports.
  - (ii) innovations in product development and processes, including indigenous tools and equipment will be the main mandate of this sub-committee. Market research and advice on related policies would be essential to make the bamboo based industry competitive with other commercial products.
- 2) Industry representatives will be nominated for a period of two years.
- 3) The non-official members shall be eligible for TA/ DA as per the permissible rules of Government of India. The TA/DA for Government & Public Sector officials will be borne by their respective organizations.

- 4) The non-official members shall travel by Air India (Economy Class) only and the tickets should be arranged by the registered/ authorized travel agencies of Government of India or from Air India website. Travel by private airlines other than Air India can be performed only in case of non-availability of Air India flight on the desired route with prior intimation to the Chairman of the Committee and submission of non-availability certificate from Air India/ authorized travel agent.

This issues in supersession to the earlier order dated 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2018 for constitution of Technical Committee II with the approval of Competent Authority in accordance with the revised Guidelines.
